



Feminists, Marxists, the Gay Community, the hard line trade unionist all are seen as being examples of radical people or groups within ou community, either rightly or wrongly. These people break the traditional mould of how we tend to expect people to think, behave an act. The average church—goer on the other hand is often seen as being the quiet, average "normal" person in our community. The one who help form the foundation that our community is based on. As a consequence these people are pointed out as being the ones who are respectable who are to be copied in their approach to life. Those that rock the boat are not seen as being good examples.

But the question arises — is the average church—goer the real followe of Christ? How can a Christian fit snugly into a community that i firmly based outside the kingdom of God. This surely would mean that a persons thoughts, behaviour and actions would have to conform to those of the community around them. This surely should be in conflict with their belief and calling as a Christian.

Now for another question — who should be the radical in society? Is a really the feminists, the gays, the unionists, the marxists? I believe they are more "pioneers", moving off into different directions, which society will eventually embrace in some form or another. After all who sets the standards for society, but society itself. Society sets the rules by which it should function, and why not — it is outside the kingdom of God and so cannot therefore be expected to conform to the things that God wants His people to conform to.

I believe that for years Christians have been making the mistake of playing the role of the moral watchdog of the community. They do no need us to tell them they are wicked, evil and sinful, for by their rule: they are not. God is outside their lives so they cannot understand the truth. All we are managing to do is to alienate them, to build a barrie between us and them. Why should we condemn them by our standard: when they are not living by them in the first place. Jesus shows this in His dealing with the woman at the well. (See John 4.) Jesus could have told her sne was sinful, that she was an adulterer and should be punished, but no, He met her at her point of need. She needed to be accepted and shown the answers to her problems. Through arousing her curiosity Jesus was able to tell her of her need for the gospel. Jesus has shown that the best way of communicating the gospel to people is by showing we care about them.


instead, we need to be vitally aware of the standards we are supposed to be living by as part of the kingdom of God. Remember the times that Jesus really got angry with those around Him was when He was dealing with the supposedly religious people of the time (the Scribes and the Pharisees) who were only involved in religion for the show and what , they could get out of it. Does our faith fit this category?

I believe that in our society we as Christians need to be the ones who are the "radicals". We need to show society that there is an alternative way to live. We need to break the mould. One prayer that virtually all Christians know is the one often called the Lords Prayer.(See Matthew 6:9-13) In this two verses come to mind;

"Your kingdom come,
Your will be done on earth
as it is in Heaven"

If we are to really pray this meaningfully, then we must be living in such a way as to be working for the coming of the kingdom of God, and be living in such a way as to Be paily carrying out the will of God. To not be doing this would be to make this prayer insincere — a fance. We must know to what sort of a ministry God has called us and be actively engaged in following that calling through.


