WHAT WOULD JESUS DO?

A new catch phrase has entered the church, it's seen in various forms on T-shirts and baseball caps, bumper stickers and Bible covers. But think what we may of "Christian Marketing" it prompts us to ask ourselves, what *would* Jesus do?

Jesus was surrounded by life situations, but reacted most unlike us. Who is not affected by things around us? though occasionally we can say that we have done what Jesus would do.

Prayer is not a five minute exercise squeezed in a busy day but a walk with God, communicating, building and sustaining the relationship. Jesus got away to pray at times, to refresh and refocus his life on Gods utmost best, and as he walked through the day, communicating with the good Father he knew what to do.

And so with us, we may need to get away to focus on God, and wrestle with issues, struggling with the call of God on our lives and the undeniable pull of the Holy Spirit towards the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5). 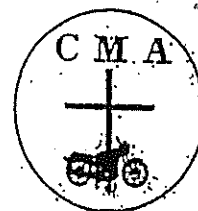

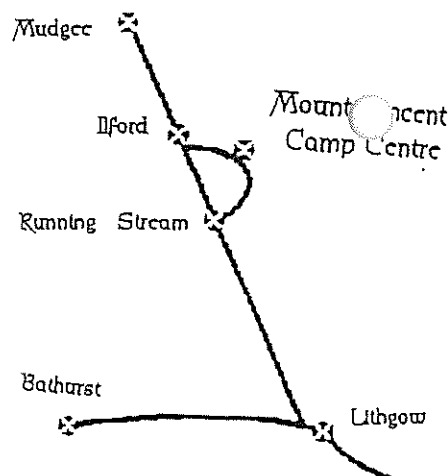
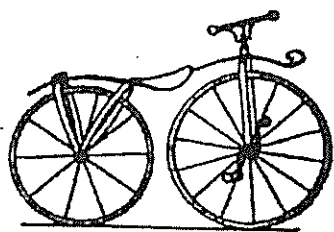
