

Mahadev Ale is one of IMM's church planters. He has been working with us since 2017.

Mahadev is a great guy! Married to Sushila, they have one son—Abinash, and three daughters—Monika, Bhumika and Reebeka.

Mahadev and Sushila have already planted one church with IMM and recently moved to a new location about 40km away where there are no churches to establish a new fellowship.

They have handed the 'Mother' church over to other leaders they have discipled and have begun the new work in Banke in mid-west Nepal. In the short time they have been serving there, 20 people have already come to the Lord.

Mahadev is one of our area co-ordinators, gifted in teaching and evangelism.

in his role as area coordinator, he travels throughout mid-west Nepal pastorally caring for his group of church planters, bringing teaching and encouragement to them personally, as well as their respective churches/fellowships.

He has been covering these vast distances by pushbike, meaning he is often away from his family for long periods, traversing roads that are not very push-bike friendly!



Your partnership with Mahadev in the gift of this motorbike will enable him to engage more frequently with the group of church planters in his care. It will also enable him to reach more villages in his own area with the gospel, giving people the opportunity to choose Jesus.






The Melbourne eastern chapter report.
